



REMOVAL

- · Disconnect the negative battery cable.
- Remove the two fresh air duct mounting bolts on the radiator.
- · Loosen the fresh air duct clamp at the intake housing.
- Remove the hose at the resonance chamber.
- Remove the frech air duct.




Remove the five cooling fan shroud bolts.




· Remove the four thermo-modulated fan nuts.


• Remove the four thermo-modulated fan cooling fan shroud at the same time.




• Loosen the two generator mounting bolts(A and B).




- Loosen the generator drive belt from the generator by loosening the adjusting bolt(C).
- Remove the generator drive belt.
- Remove the fan pulley.
- Remove the four splash guard mounting bolts and splash guard.




• Loosen the A/C idler puller nut(A).



- Remove the A/C drive belt by loosening the adjusting bolt.
- Loosen the power steering pump lock bolt and mounting bolt.




- Remove the power steering belt.
- Remove five bolts and the upper timing belt cover. Refer to Timing Belt.
- Remove two bolts and the lower timing cover. Refer to Timing Belt.
- Loosen the tensioner lock bolt and pivot the tensionder pulley outward to remove the tension from the timing belt, then retighten the tensioner lock bolt.



Tightening Torque : 27-38ft lbs(37-52N m)

- Mark the timing belt rotation for proper reinstallation if it reused.
- Remove the timing belt.
